

The Application Fee for the NCRT Training and Certification Process is \$995.00.

There are four phases to the training and certification process: taking an E-Course, attending an Introduction to ROMA Training (in-person or virtual), preparation of a portfolio to demonstrate understanding of the concepts and use of the practices, and a final exam. The Application Fee for the NCRI Training and Certification Process is \$775.00.
